

Invitation for round 9 and 10 Alpe Adria BMX Championship 2016 on July 30th and 31st 2016

Eligible are all male and female riders with a valid BMX-Licence. Both, the "Alpe-Adria BMX Championship 2016" and the "BMX-Club Championship" is announced as open. As for the end results all riders will be placed. Even though if they are not coming out of Austria, Hungary, Slovenia, Italy or Germany. Within this Cup there will be only an overall standings resulting out of all single races.

The daily overall standings are obliged to the organizer.

The race categories are defined as follows...

Boys/Girls <8, Boys/Girls 9-10, Boys/Girls 11-12,
Boys/Girls 13-14, Boys/Girls 15-16, Men 17+,
Women 17+(20"+24"), Cruiser Men all Ages.

In the event that in one category less than five (5) riders are registered, those riders will be transferred to the next higher category. In the daily overall standings those merged categories will be ranked separately.

In the event that the men 17+ category has less than five (5) riders registered, this category will be merged with the boys 15/16 category. If the women 17+ category has less than five (5) riders registered, this category will be merged with the boys 15/16 category.

Amateurs are categorized as follows...

Category <8, 9-10, 11-12, 13-14, 15+.
Girls and Boys merged together.

Club Championship

As a special event it is planned to have a sidecar race (minimum is three (3) registered sidecar teams)

Competition regulations

Valid across all races is the UCI Rulebook in its latest release. It is mandatory for all riders using their national or international number. Background and number color need to be compliant to the UCI regulatory.

If two riders of an Alpe-Adria-Event carrying equivalent numbers, the foreign rider need to add the country code as a prefix to his number (A = Austria, H = Hungary, S = Slovenia, I = Italy, G = Germany)

Click-Pedals are permitted as of age group 2003 boys/girls and older.
